Dancing to the Music of John Lennon at Yung Wing

On December 16, the students at Yung Wing School in Chinatown put on a show as National Dance Institute's year-end performance. The theme this year was the music of John Lennon, a member of England's well-known rock band The Beatles. Teachers of NDI have adapted John Lennon's songs to simple but lively dance movements for the students to learn. This also gave the students an opportunity to learn about the life of this legendary rock singer.

Yoko Ono, John Lennon's widow, wasn't able to come to the show but she dedicated a poem entitled Make Your Heart Dance to the students, encouraging them to always keep a warm and inspiring heart when facing the challenges in life.

Led by the dance teachers, hundreds of 5th Grade students danced enthusiastically to show the different dance steps they have learned, creating such excitement that the audience stood up and joined in .
