BILL IRWIN


Tony, Drama Desk, Obie, and MacArthur 'Genius' Award Winner

At National Dance Institute (NDI), we believe the arts have a unique power to engage all children and motivate them toward excellence.

Through our award-winning arts education programs, we serve children of diverse backgrounds, abilities, and socioeconomic positions—transcending systemic barriers and expanding opportunities for all children to become their best. Our professional teaching artists encourage in students a love of dance and music, a curiosity about the world, and a desire to achieve. These dedicated teachers help our young dancers learn to work together as they develop persistence, empathy, and confidence to support their success in school and in life.

Since our founding in 1976 by New York City Ballet principal dancer Jacques d'Amboise, NDI has empowered the lives of more than two million children. NDI developed a unique, proven teaching methodology that uses dance and music to improve children's critical thinking, develop their global perspective, and hone their social-emotional, communication, and collaboration skills. Under the artistic direction of Kay Gayner, NDI has continued to deepen its practices through the lens of inclusion and diversity, and fulfills our core mission of offering our programs to all children **free of charge**.

Our joyfully rigorous and inclusive In-School Program takes place during the school day, centering the arts in the curriculum and ensuring success for every child. Our Advanced Programs give our most motivated children the opportunity to deepen their dance and music study by joining our SWAT Team (Scholarships for the Willing, Achieving, and Talented) or Celebration Team and by attending our Irene Diamond Summer Institute.

The NDI DREAM Project (Dancers Realize Excellence through Arts and Movement) is our inclusive dance program providing children with and without disabilities the opportunity to perform together. Videos in our DREAM Project@ Home and ndiLIVE! on YouTube series bring

on-demand dance and music classes to the public via social media and allow children everywhere to experience the joy and magic of NDI programs free of charge.

NDI disseminates our acclaimed teaching method through the NDI Collaborative for Teaching & Learning, a professional development program for teaching artists, dance educators, musicians, and organizations worldwide. Every year, professional artists and educators from around the globe participate in our trainings and emerge from this transformative experience with an advanced set of teaching tools and a deepened understanding of the power of the arts in education.

Throughout our history, NDI has seeded programs both nationally and internationally. In the United States, there are currently 12 Associates of National Dance Institute (ANDIs) that utilize the NDI Method to serve over 30,000 children every year. Internationally, NDI has been working in Shanghai, China and in Beirut, Lebanon to train teachers in NDI's groundbreaking methodology and to promote the social development of children, helping them gain confidence through the study of dance, the arts, and international collaboration.

In the fall of 2011, NDI opened the doors to our permanent home—the Jacques d'Amboise Center for Learning & the Arts located at 217 West 147th Street in Harlem. NDI's Center is home to three dance studios, two art galleries, green rooms, administrative offices, and the Howard Gilman Performance Space, which has seating for 175 and has been used for NDI classes, rehearsals, performances, and events. NDI's Center has become a beacon for children, teachers, and artists in our local Harlem community, throughout New York City, and worldwide.

Tiffany Rea-Fisher, Inc. is the Helen Stambler Neuberger Artist-in-Residence for 2023-2024. In this role, she has been working with NDI children and Teaching Artists throughout the year, setting choreography on NDI Advanced Teams dancers.

Rea-Fisher is currently the Artistic Director of EMERGE125, a Mellon Foundation grant-funded dance company headquartered out of Harlem and the Adirondacks, currently in residence at The Flea Theater. She is also the dance curator for Bryant Park Picnic Performances; the Executive Director of the Adirondack Diversity Initiative; and is the cofounder of Inception to Exhibition, a non-profit that facilitates low cost, high quality space rentals for use by artists from a variety of disciplines.

Over the course of her career, Rea-Fisher has been commissioned by the Dallas Black Dance Theater, the NYC Department of Transportation, Utah Repertory Dance Theater, and The National Gallery of Art in D.C. Her works have been seen on stage at the Joyce, the Apollo, New York City Center, Joe's Pub, Aaron Davis Hall, Bryant Park, Red Bull Stadium, Works & Process at the Guggenheim, the Children's Museum of Manhattan, Chelsea Factory, and New York

Live Arts. She has worked extensively with fashion designers to present their works, including for events and films with Louis Vuitton and Paola Hernández.

Among Rea-Fisher's more recent accomplishments is the premiere of her 2022 Dance Theatre of Harlem commission, Sounds of Hazel, celebrating the life of the classical pianist, singer,

Hollywood star, and trailblazing activist Hazel Scott.

Rea-Fisher is a COHI member of the International Association of Blacks in Dance, an Advisory Board member of Dance/NYC, a Bessies Award Selection Committee member, and a proud member of Women of Color in the Arts. Rea-Fisher was the first dance curator for the interdisciplinary arts organization The Tank, where she now sits on their Board of Trustees, and served for many years as the Director of the Lake Placid School of Dance. She is a 7-time consecutive AUDELCO award nominee, a 2022 Toulmin Fellow, a National Dance Project Award winner, a Creatives Rebuild New York Awardee, a John Brown Spirit Award recipient, and was awarded a citation from the City of New York for her cultural contributions. education, and all of her many satellite projects.
